From 4 to 8 March 2013, representatives of the Headquarters Multinational Corps Northeast (HQ MNC NE) participated in the Main Storyline Event List (MSEL) II Conference in Riga, Latvia, as part of the Headquarters' preparation for the exercise Saber Strike 2013 (SbS13).

Each military exercise, no matter whether it involves troop movement or assumes a form of a “*computer-assisted command post exercise*”, needs to be prepared long in advance. It requires taking into account not only a number of “*details*”, such as communication systems, accommodation, transport, furniture, and equipment set-up, but also a solid operational planning and an overall current scenario situation development. The MSEL II Conference was the next preparatory step forward for the upcoming exercise Saber Strike 2013.
